

Former Bush Aide Sentenced to 30 Months in Prison

A 29-year-old former Bush administration aide was sentenced today to 2 1/2 years in federal prison for stealing nearly \$600,000 from a nonprofit group that promotes democracy in Cuba.

Felipe E. Sixto of Miami pleaded guilty last year in U.S. District Court in the District to stealing from a federally funded program. Today, U.S. District Judge Reggie B. Walton called the crime an "elaborate scheme" that badly damaged the nonprofit group, the Center for a Free Cuba, where Sixto worked from 2003 through July 2007.
