



A critically ill Turkish boy has had his life saved after scientists were able to read his genome quickly and work out that he had a wrong diagnosis.

The scientists writing in the journal, *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*, say they completed the analysis of his blood in just 10 days. They were able to see that he had a mutation on a gene that coded for a gut disease and tell his doctors. Clinical tests proved that the boy had the disease and he is now recovering.

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
