Now, <u>Bloomberg reports</u>, none of Trump's lawyers working on issues related to the Russia probe have clearance. Jay Sekulow, Trump's personal attorney and the host of *Jay Sekulow Live!*,

replaced Dowd, but he's still waiting to be cleared. The newest members of the team — Rudy Giuliani, Marty Raskin and Jane Raskin — haven't been on the job long enough to get cleared themselves and none of them told Bloomberg whether they'd even sought such clearance.
